Dear Kindergarten Parent:

In order to attend school, your child must be immunized as required by the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. As of August 2020, the minimum requirements are as follows:

Diphtheria	4 doses for students less than 7 years of age
Tetanus	4 doses for students less than 7 years of age
Pertussis	4 doses for students less than 7 years of age
Polio (injectable)	3 doses
Measles (rubeola)	2 doses
Rubella (German Measles)	2 doses
Mumps	2 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2 doses, positive blood test of immunity or physician documented history of chickenpox month and year

Proof of immunization compliance must be provided prior to the first day of school. If your child needs additional immunizations, please schedule an appointment with your healthcare provider.
