Dear Pre-Kindergarten Parent:

In order to attend school, your child must be immunized as required by the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. As of August 2021, the minimum requirements are as follows:

Diphtheria	4 doses for students less than 7 years of age
Tetanus	4 doses for students less than 7 years of age
Pertussis	4 doses for students less than 7 years of age
Polio (injectable)	3 doses
Measles (rubeola)	1 dose
Rubella (German Measles)	1 dose
Mumps	1 dose
Hib	At least one dose after 12 months of age
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella (Chickenpox)	1 dose, positive blood test of immunity or physician documented history of chickenpox month and year
PCV7 (Pevnar)	1 dose required if younger than 5 years of age

Proof of immunization compliance must be provided prior to the first day of school. If your child needs additional immunizations, please schedule an appointment with your healthcare provider. The data and results of your child's blood lead screening are also required.
